The Excellence Fund will enhance the Extension mission with funds used solely to support the operations of the OCES. Together, we can secure Extension's legacy into the future.

ENDOWMENTS SUPPORT EXTENSION

- An individual, company or organization may create and/or endow funds that can be donated as a lump sum or over a period of time to help financially support Extension. Creating endowments that last in perpetuity provides sustained annual funding.
- You can include OSU and Extension in your estate plans to establish endowments to build a lasting legacy.
- The funds from an endowment can help local Extension offices by supporting an Extension educator or paraprofessional position, general operating expenses, and/or expenses related to a course or program.
- Additionally, funds can establish endowments for Extension area specialists, faculty, research, programming support, scholarships and more.

Endowments are an integral part of maintaining high quality Extension services and other university programs. The endowment minimum is \$25,000, but outright annual support of any value can be contributed to existing funds such as the OCES Excellence Fund. Endowments to fully fund a local educator position would be substantially higher.
